

Directions on what to do on the emergency

1. Invasion including air-raid, assaults expected

<h3><u>Preliminary Warning against Air-Raid for Civil Defense</u></h3>

(1) What to do in Daytime

- *Prepare to move to the shelter, and have children and aged people take shelter first*
- *Check the personal protective outfits such as gas mask to guard against the chemical, biological and radiological attacks*
- *Turn off the electric power and gas that may cause a fire.*
- *Running cars should slow down while preparing to take shelter and refrain from entering into high level roads or the urban center.*
- *Operations in the crowded place such as movie theaters, stadiums, terminals, and department stores should be suspended, and inform people of the alarm and have them take shelter in orderly fashion.*

(2) What to do during Night time

- *Turn off lights indoors and outdoors after preparing to move to the shelter, and have children and aged people take shelter first*
- *Check the personal protective outfits such as gas mask to guard against the chemical, biological and radiological attacks*

- *Turn off the gas and electric power that may cause a fire*
- *Running cars should turn down headlight and slow down while preparing to take shelter, and refrain from enter into high level roads and urban centers.*
- *Operations in the crowded place such as movie theaters, stadiums, terminals, and department stores should be suspended, and inform people of the alarm and have them take shelter in orderly fashion and make preparations for putting out lights.*

2. Invasion including air-raid, assaults occurred

<h3><u>Civil Defense Warning against Air-Raid</u></h3>

(1) What to do in Day time

- *Take shelter promptly and in orderly fashion in underground shelter using natural features on the earth*
- *Wear protective outfit such as gas mask and replaceable outfits to guard against chemical, biological and radiological attacks and take shelter promptly*
- *Running automobiles should park at the empty lot nearby or on the right side of the road and have the passengers take shelter in the safe place*
- *Operations in the crowded place such as movie theaters, stadiums, terminals, and department stores should be suspended, and inform people of the alarm and have them take shelter in orderly fashion*

- *Abide by the law and order in the shelter and keep listening to broadcasting and follow the instructions issued by National Emergency Management Agency*

(2) What to do during Night time

- *Put out lights indoors and outdoors immediately and take shelter promptly and in orderly fashion*
- *Wear protective outfit such as gas mask and replaceable outfits to guard against chemical, biological and radiological attacks and take shelter promptly and put out lights entirely.*
- *In the place such as the emergency room or major industrial facilities where lights are inevitable, shield the light completely with the blackout curtain so that lights cannot shine through*
- *Abide by the law and order in the shelter and keep listening to broadcasting and follow the instructions issued by National Emergency Management Agency*

Civil Defense Warning against Disaster

(1) Heavy rainfall

- *Confirm whether children and aged people have taken shelter and disseminate warning status*
- *Move to the shelter along the shelter path that has become familiar in advance*
- *Carry emergency food, flash light, radio, and first-aid medicines*

- *Avoid steel tower, electric pole, and big trees during thunder and lightening*
- *Residents in lowland, chronic inundated areas, isolated areas, landslide areas should take shelter promptly*
- *Mountain climbers, campers in the valleys should move promptly to the safe place*
- *When abruptly isolated by flood, go up to the roof of the building or high area and make a flag of white cloth and ask help by waving it or making smoke*
- *When damage occurs by heavy rainfall, report it immediately to nearby government office .(1588-3650)*
- *Until the disaster warning is lifted, listen to the disaster broadcasting in the shelter and follow the instructions from remedy headquarters*

(2) Typhoon

- *Confirm whether children and aged people have taken shelter and disseminate warning status*
- *Move to the shelter along the shelter path that has become familiar in advance*
- *Carry along emergency food, flash light, radio, and first-aid medicines*
- *Residents in lowland, chronic inundated areas, isolated areas, landslide areas should take shelter promptly*
- *People having sea bath on the beach, campers in the valleys should move promptly to the safe place*
- *Various boats on the sea should promptly take shelter to the nearby harbor*
- *Whendamage occurs by typhoon, report it immediately to nearby government office .(1588-3650)*

- *Until the disaster warning is lifted, listen to the disaster broadcasting in the shelter and follow the instructions from remedy headquarters*

(3) Tsunami

- *Alert residents in the lowland of the tsunami*
- *Move to temporary shelters or move to higher place as soon as possible*
- *Keep from exercising on the coastal road*
- *Moving vehicles should move quickly to the road on a higher place*
- *Sailing boats should wait far away from harbor*
- *Ships in anchoring move away from harbor as far away as possible*
- *Do not move to the lowland near the shore until special weather report on tsunami is lifted*

(4) Earthquake

- *Protect the body under the desk and table in the building, and move to the open place such as park and square while escaping out of building*
- *Turn off the gas and move to the nearby open place as soon as possible*
- *Call 119 and put it out when fire breaks out*
- *Listen carefully to the radio, and act according to the direction of related authorities*
